



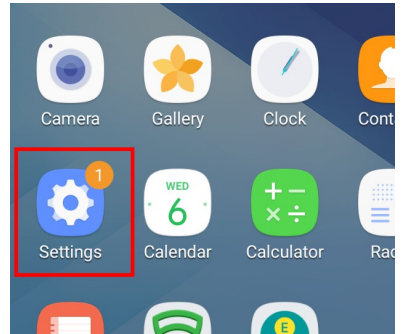
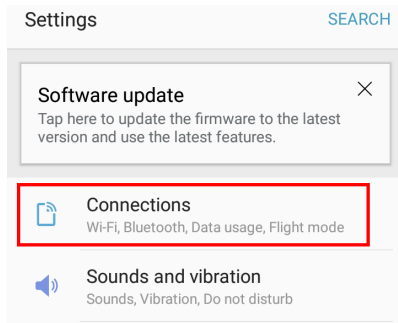
Connecting to the Wireless Network (eduroam)

eduroam allows staff and students to take their wireless devices to other educational institutions worldwide, that support eduroam, and connect using their De Montfort University username and password. You can access eduroam where you see this logo.

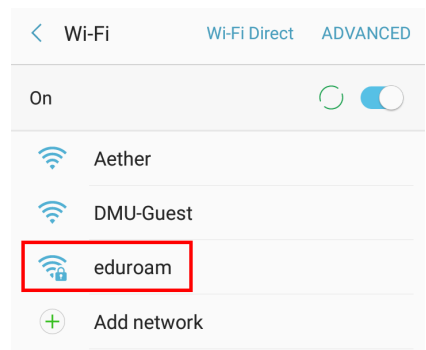


How to connect to eduroam using Android phones & tablets

- From the main menu, tap **Settings**
- Now tap **Connections**, then **Wi-Fi**



- In the list of Wi-Fi networks, tap **eduroam**




- Enter the following details:

Username: Your unique P-number found on your student ID card, followed by @dmu.ac.uk *e.g. P1734627X@dmu.ac.uk*

Password: Unless you have already changed it, this will be your date of birth in the following format: dd/mm/yy *e.g. 16/07/98*

- Click **Connect**

- You should now be connected to eduroam Wi-Fi
